

**DATA PROTECTION STATEMENT  
NATIONAL CENTRE FOR RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT**

Pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter: "GDPR"), we inform you that:

- 1) The controller of your personal data is the National Centre for Research and Development (NCBR) with its registered office in Warsaw (00-801), Chmielna 69.
- 2) You may contact the Data Protection Officer (DPO) at the following email address: [iod@ncbr.gov.pl](mailto:iod@ncbr.gov.pl), or by post to the above address with the note "Data Protection Officer".
- 3) Your personal data is processed for the purpose of implementing the project *"The Power of Didactics – development of qualifications and competences of the staff of the University of Lodz"*, carried out under the European Funds for Social Development 2021–2027 programme ("FERS"), in particular for project evaluation and selection, conclusion of the co-financing agreement, project monitoring, reporting, communication, publication, evaluation, financial management, verification and control, audit, evaluation of information and promotional activities, reception, evaluation and financial settlement of the project, determining participant eligibility, and for the purpose of establishing, pursuing, or defending legal claims.
- 4) Your personal data is processed based on the above purpose, i.e. the processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest (Article 6(1)(e) GDPR), and NCBR is authorised to process your personal data pursuant to the Act of 30 April 2010 on the National Centre for Research and Development in relation to the tasks defined therein, and based on the Act of 28 April 2022 on the principles of implementing tasks financed from European funds in the 2021–2027 financial perspective, in particular Chapter 18 of this Act (Article 6(1)(c) GDPR).
- 5) Your personal data has been obtained either directly from you or from public registers or from institutions and entities involved in the implementation of the project, in particular from applicants, beneficiaries, and partners.
- 6) NCBR processes your personal data as included in the application for co-financing or provided in the course of performing the tasks mentioned in point 3 of this clause.
- 7) Providing personal data is necessary for the implementation of the above-mentioned purpose. Refusal to provide data will result in the inability to carry out the necessary actions.
- 8) Personal data will be processed for the period necessary to achieve the purpose indicated in point 3, and then for archival purposes for a period in accordance with the NCBR's filing instructions and the Uniform File Classification System.

- 9) The recipients of your personal data will be public authorities and entities performing public tasks or acting on behalf of public authorities, within the scope and for the purposes arising from the law. Entities providing services essential to NCBR's operations may also receive your data — in particular, **NCBR+ sp. z o.o.** which supports the execution of tasks. Data may also be transferred to IT partners, entities providing technical or organisational support, document archiving and destruction, postal, courier, payment, and marketing services.
- 10) You have the right to request access to your personal data, rectify, erase and transfer your data, restrict or object to the processing of your personal data by NCBR. To exercise these rights, please contact the Data Protection Officer at the email address provided in point 2 above.
- 11) You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.
- 12) Your personal data will not be subject to automated decision-making, including profiling.
- 13) Your personal data will not be transferred to a third country.
